

Thank you for choosing Panorama Orthopedics & Spine Center. Outlined below is the information that you may find useful during your entire injection process.

- Now that you have chosen to have an injection, orders will be generated and submitted to out pre-authorization team. Panorama Orthopedics will evaluate your medical history and may contact you for further information.
- Prior to your injection our pre-authorization team will contact your insurance company to obtain authorization for your injection. Once authorization is obtained a member of our injection/surgery scheduling team will contact you.
- They will contact you to discuss the date, time, and location of you injection. Dr. Knight/Horner performs the injections at the Golden Ridge Surgery Center (GRSC) or at Panorama Orthopedics & Spine Center (Golden office).
- > Dr. Knight/Horner will want to see you 2 weeks following your injection for further assessment.
- Please remember you must speak with you primary care physician prior to your injection if you are currently taking blood thinners. Failure to contact your primary care physician may result in your injection being cancelled.
- ➤ If you are diabetic please make sure to notify the injection/surgery scheduler to insure the appropriate injection time is scheduled. This will help to insure that you are not going without food any longer than necessary.
- ➤ All questions regarding insurance, time, location, and date of your injection will be handled through out pre-authorization team. Please contact them directly with any concerns at #303-233-1223 ext. 7331
